

**BASICS CHECKLIST**

As a Fly UK pilot we expect you to have a basic knowledge of flying in flight simulator. We want to encourage a high standard of flying and have created a variety of training documents and courses to help pilots expand their skills. The checklist below states the basic level of knowledge we expects to have.

If there is anything on this checklist you feel you need some more help with, don't understand, or just want to go over again, then please make use of our training documents. Remember, the Fly UK Training Academy also offers one2one online training sessions in all areas covered by the basics document.

<b>Flight Simulator Settings</b>	Have you got you got your flight sim setup correctly?	
<b>Payload &amp; Fuel</b>	Do you know how to load your aircraft correctly?	
<b>Active Runway</b>	Do you know how to determine the active runway?	
<b>Weather</b>	Do you know how the weather will affect your flight? Do you know how to read a METAR?	
<b>QNH &amp; Altimeter</b>	Do you know what QNH is? Do you know how to set it and when to change it?	
<b>Flight Plans/SIDS/STARS</b>	Do you know where to get a flight plan from and how to read it? Do you know about SIDS and STARS and how to fly them?	
<b>Flying a Flight Plan</b>	Do you know how to follow your flight plan? For example using a payware aircraft FMC / vasFMC / FS Commander.	
<b>AIRACS</b>	Do you know what they are, where to get them, and when to update them?	
<b>Aircraft Checklists</b>	Do you use them? or know where to get them?	
<b>Charts</b>	Can you read charts? Do you understand them? Do you know where to get them?	
<b>Add-Ons</b>	Are you aware of where to find add-ons to enhance your flight simulator experience?	
<b>Online Flying</b>	Do you know about online flying and the different networks?
